

The Office of Inspector General for the Department of the Interior is seeking a highly skilled senior executive to join the OIG's team as the Deputy Inspector General. The OIG is consistently ranked as number 1 in the best places to work in the Department of the Interior and also places in the top ten percent for all federal agency subcomponent offices in the best places to work rankings created by the Partnership for Public Service. In 2019, we ranked fifth among OIGs in the best places to work rankings.

The Deputy Inspector General will work closely with the Inspector General to lead the full range of OIG activities, including assisting the IG in developing and implementing strategic initiatives, directing the OIG's nationwide audit and investigations programs, supervising legal and administrative management programs, and engaging with critical stakeholders, including Department leadership and Members of Congress and their staffs. The Deputy will act with full authority as the Inspector General in his absence and serves as the "first assistant" to the IG under the Federal Vacancies Act, as amended. This is a Senior Executive Service (SES) career reserved position.

The ideal candidate will have a minimum of 5 years of executive leadership experience (SES or SES-equivalent of any OPM series) in the federal accountability community, preferably with experience in a medium or large OIG, as well as substantial direct experience working with senior political appointees, Congress, and the media. The candidate must meet the high ethical and integrity standards of the OIG and embrace the organizational values of objectivity and independence, integrity, and getting results. The candidate must thrive in a fast-pace environment that values open communication, feedback, and constructive dialogue from all levels in the organization.
