The individual will serve as Acting Counsel to the Inspector General until the recruitment and appointment of a permanent Counsel to the Inspector General is completed. The position is graded at the GS-15 level and is non-supervisory. Applicants must be current federal or legislative branch civilian employees eligible to be considered at the GS-15 level.

The individual will serve as the principal legal advisor to the Inspector General. In addition to assisting the Inspector General with briefings and other interactions with the FTC Chairman, Commissioners, Commission leadership, and Congress, the candidate will:

- provide expert legal advice to the Inspector General and all OIG staff on investigative, audit, inspection, and Freedom of Information Act issues;
- work collaboratively with the Lead Investigator in ensuring evidence is appropriately documented, and in developing reports of investigation;
- prepare subpoenas and ensure the proper completion and filing of legal documents in cases under review;
- represent the OIG at judicial proceedings for the enforcement of subpoenas and in obtaining court orders in furtherance of investigations, inspections, and audits; and
- recommend, develop, and institute policies and practices governing the conduct of investigations.
