Senator Jon Ossoff (D-GA) is seeking Office of Inspector General staff interested in a one-year, non-reimbursable detail on his Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations (PSI) staff. Responsibilities will include developing investigative plans, conducting briefings and interviews, reviewing document productions, drafting reports and memoranda, and preparing for hearings. Candidates must have strong writing, analytical, communication, and organizational skills, and significant experience conducting or leading major oversight or investigative projects. Ideal candidates will have a background in one or more of the following issue areas: human trafficking; organized crime, money laundering, and other types of financial crime; civil liberties and other issues related to law enforcement and detention practices; or privacy and other challenges facing the technology industry. PSI staff will work with OIG human resources to provide additional information or coordinate logistics, if necessary.
