Larry Malenich is the Managing Director of GAO's Financial Management and Assurance team. He has been a Director in FMA since 2012. He has experience in leading both financial and performance audits across a broad range of federal and private sector entities and programs. Larry was the Lead Director on the audit of the consolidated financial statements of the U. S. government from 2015 to 2017, and helped plan and oversee the initial audit of the General Fund, which accounts for the trillions of dollars of cash receipts and cash disbursements for the government.

From 2004 until 2008, Larry served as a Congressional Advisor in GAO's Congressional Relations Office, with liaison responsibility for several congressional committees, including the House and Senate Committees on Appropriations, Budget, and Veterans Affairs, as well as the House Committee on Homeland Security.

Prior to joining GAO in 1991, Larry worked in the private sector for an independent public accounting firm where he managed a diverse client base of manufacturers, wholesalers, and oil and gas companies.
