Terry Letko is a Senior Acquisition Advisor in the Department of Transportation (DOT) OIG's Office of the Assistant Inspector General for Acquisition and Procurement Audits. He is one of four program directors responsible for managing procurement and contract audit teams and assists teams performing acquisition audits. Terry has been with the DOT OIG since 1999. Before becoming involved with contract and acquisition management audits, Terry previously directed financial management audits at DOT entities and audits of the

Prior to joining the DOT-OIG Terry spent 20 years as a contract auditor at either the DOD-OIG, where he was a project manager in the Office of Audit Policy and Oversight, or the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) where he performed various duties, including supervisory auditor, at the Fairfax Branch Office.
