The Leadership and Mission Support Academy (L&MSA) is requesting your support for the upcoming 2020 CIGIE Fellows Program. The success of the program is driven by the voluntary participation of OIGs offering high-quality rotational assignments and SES mentoring for CIGIE Fellows. Hosting and mentoring a Fellow is an enriching experience for the Fellow, the hosting OIG, and participating SES mentors.

The program is a competitive senior leadership development program sponsored by the CIGIE Professional Development Committee (PDC). It is designed to provide a comprehensive inter-agency Fellowship experience to high-performing OIG professionals. The program includes a rotational assignment, SES mentoring, and multiple training and cohort developmental activities that broadens the perspectives of participants and helps prepare them for future senior leadership positions.

Developmental rotations can be either part-time or full-time and are four months to one year in duration.
