Faustino Gonzalez joined the NSF OIG staff in November 2014 as a Senior Special Agent. His previous assignment was at FLETC as a Senior Instructor with the Investigative Operations Division, Financial Fraud Institute where he coordinated and taught in fraud investigation, internet investigation, suspension and debarment programs.

For 25 years, he was assigned as a U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command (CID) Special Agent/Computer Crimes Intelligence Manager where he conducted felony criminal investigations and also developed and maintained a viable criminal intelligence program in support of computer crime investigations.

Mr. Gonzalez also attended numerous advance contracting developmental courses from the Acquisition University. Mr. Gonzalez, upon his retirement from the U.S. Army, joined the Defense Criminal Investigation Service (DCIS) as a Program Investigative Review Specialist for the Economic Crimes Directorate.

Mr. Gonzalez career also includes being an Administrative Investigator, National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) responsible for investigating allegations of fraud, waste, and abuse, and gross mismanagement. Some of Mr. Gonzalez's investigations included numerous undercover narcotic purchases, numerous death investigations and fraud investigations.

Mr. Gonzalez also performed personal security for 6 years for the Secretary of Defense.
