Re: Notice of Need for Extension of 30-Day Review Period

Dear Chairmen:

The Integrity Committee (IC) of the Council of Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE), received allegations of wrongdoing pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 11(d)(4) of the Inspector General Act of 1978 as amended by the IG Empowerment Act. The allegations received an initial review within seven days, as required by 5 U.S.C. § 11(d)(5)(A). Based on that review, the allegations were referred to the IC for review pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 11(d)(5)(B). The review pursuant to § 11(d)(5)(B), which must take place within 30 days, is to determine whether to refer the allegations of wrong doing to the Chairperson of the IC to initiate an investigation. Pursuant to § 11(d)(5)(B)(ii), this 30-day review period may be extended an additional 30 days if the IC provides written notice to these Committees with a description of why the additional time is needed to evaluate the allegation of wrongdoing.

We are writing to notify you that the IC needs additional time to evaluate IC complaint #911. The IC recently requested a response to the allegation from the subject. We expect a response shortly. Once the IC reviews the response, we will decide the appropriate next steps and notify these Committees if there are further delays.

We appreciate Congress's patience as we continue to transition the management of the IC from the Federal Bureau of Investigation to CIGIE, including bringing on necessary staff, and developing the required infrastructure.
