Re: Notice of Need for Extension of 30-Day Review Period

Dear Chairmen and Ranking Members:

The Integrity Committee (IC) of the Council of Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE), received allegations of wrongdoing pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 11(d)(4) of the Inspector General Act of 1978 as amended by the IG Empowerment Act. Pursuant to § 11(d)(5)(B), the IC has 30 days to review the allegations to determine whether to initiate an investigation. Pursuant to § 11(d)(5)(B)(ii), this 30-day review period may be extended an additional 30 days if the IC provides written notice to these Committees with a description of why the additional time is needed to evaluate the allegation of wrongdoing.

We are writing to notify you that the IC needs additional time to evaluate IC complaints #912 and #913. For complaint #912, the IC requested a response to the allegations from the subject. For complaint #913, the IC requested additional information from the complainant. Once the IC reviews these responses, the IC can decide on the appropriate next steps and notify these Committees if there are further delays.

We appreciate Congress's patience as we continue to transition the management of the IC from the Federal Bureau of Investigation to CIGIE, including bringing on necessary staff, and developing the required infrastructure.
