


Percentage of Internet Users Per Country

Areas Receiving Most Negative Social Media Comments









Case Study: US Dept. of VA


The Problem

The VA has taken some bad publicity over the past few years, including inadequate healthcare at the nation's most well known government hospital: Walter Reed. In the midst of creating its strategic plan for the next two years, the agency had concerns about public opinion with regard to its programs.

The Analysis

Using our sophisticated tracking tools and human analysts, we provided the VA with a small but informative study analyzing what patients and VA's own employees were saying about the agency on social media across a sample of 5,000 public comments.

Type of Complaint About Dept of VA Healthcare



The Results

The research showed that while only 5% complained of receiving inadequate healthcare, 50% complained of receiving poor customer service at VA facilities. This alerted the VA to the presence of a major issue in their customer service, providing the insights to support shifting some funding from healthcare to service initiatives. In addition, the research identified 7 specific facilities where complaints were the highest and 4 facilities where customers were noting significant improvements in customer service. Additional research at these four facilities would reveal the policy shifts that triggered these online compliments.




