

## **Jeanette J. McMillian**

Jeanette J. McMillian is the Counsel for the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community (IC IG). As Counsel, she manages the Counsel Office staff, conducts legal and policy reviews, provides legal guidance on pertinent IC IG matters, serves as liaison to congressional staff and members, and is Chair of the IC IG Forum Counsels Committee. In addition to her duties as the Counsel, she manages the IC IG intelligence oversight portfolio, which includes reporting to the President's Intelligence Oversight Board.

Ms. McMillian participated in developing the legislation for the IC IG as well as the confirmation of the first IC IG, Mr. I. Charles McCullough, III. Prior to joining the IG staff, Ms. McMillian supported the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) Office of Legislative Affairs (OLA) and worked with congressional staff on pertinent IC legislation including the FISA Amendments Act of 2008, the IC Whistleblower Protection Enhancement Act, and annual Intelligence Authorization Acts.

In addition to her service in the ODNI, Ms. McMillian served in the National Counterterrorism Center, where she analyzed the legal and regulatory aspects of strategic counterterrorism plans, and in the Central Intelligence Agency, where she served as an Assistant General Counsel during the establishment of the ODNI. Ms. McMillian has in-depth knowledge of National Security laws especially the National Security Act of 1947, as amended; Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended; Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004; Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act; Freedom of Information Act; Privacy Act; and the Intelligence Community Whistleblowers Protection Act.
