

Biography of Edward C. Nucci

Edward C. Nucci is presently a Managing Assistant United States Attorney in the Southern District of Florida. Mr. Nucci has been a federal prosecutor since 1983 in three U.S. Attorney's Offices: the Western District of Pennsylvania, the Middle District of Florida, and the Southern District of Florida. He has served in a variety of supervisory capacities, including as Criminal Chief of the Southern District of Florida. During this time period, he has also served on details to the Office of Independent Counsel in the investigation of former Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, and to the U.S. Department of Justice as Senior Litigation Counsel to the Counterterrorism Section and acting Chief of the Public Integrity Section. He has worked in private practice at the law firms of Akin Gump in Washington, D.C. and Holland & Knight in Florida. Mr. Nucci received his undergraduate degree from the University of Notre Dame and his law degree from the University of Pittsburgh.
