Appointed in June 2006, Mr. Piccolo is the principal advisor to The Auditor General, U.S. Army, on all matters relating to the Agency's audit mission. His responsibilities include developing and overseeing the execution of the Agency's strategic audit plan to ensure it meets the needs of Army leadership and overall management of audit operations to include prioritizing audit workload, allocating audit resources, and optimizing audit processes. In addition, Mr. Piccolo directs the planning, execution, and reporting of the Army's most sensitive and significant efforts. He collaborates with other accountability organizations such as DoD Inspector General and Government Accountability Office on issues concerning the Agency's audit plans, projects and results.

Mr. Piccolo was selected into the Senior Executive Service in February 2005. Until June of 2006 he served as Deputy Auditor General, Forces and Financial Audits. Mr. Piccolo advised The Auditor General on all matters pertaining to Agency programs for auditing the Army's major functional areas of forces and manpower management; financial operations; information technology; Corps of Engineers and civil works; health and morale, welfare and recreation; environment, safety and chemical; and the Agency's Pacific Region operations.
